MAYOR'S MEDAL OF HONOR CRITERIA

(1) VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR:

An individual who sustains and promotes creative endeavors in one or more of the following activities:

- a) A member of an organization who has shown outstanding dedication through projects and service this calendar year. Examples include, but are not limited to, church, 4-H, music, theater, school and civic groups. (Nominations for City of Windom boards, committees or commissions should be submitted in the City Service category.)

(2) CITY SERVICE:

- a) An employee of the City who provides a service **above and beyond** the call of duty.
- b) Or a volunteer who provides extraordinary service to the City while fulfilling duties of appointment to service on a board, committee or commission.

(3) COMMUNITY-WIDE SERVICE:

- a) Any member of the community who donates personal time and ability to achieve a goal to the benefit of the citizens of Windom.

(4) SERVICES BY SENIOR CITIZENS:

A senior citizen who engages in one or more of the following activities:

- a) Exemplary service among peers;
- b) Creative endeavors;
- c) Promotion of health, economic and other issues responding to the needs of senior citizens.

(5) CHALLENGE AWARD:

- a) A member of the community who has overcome personal obstacles, such as physical disabilities, financial hardships or health setbacks, and become an inspiration to others.

(6) HUMAN SERVICES:

- a) An individual providing humanitarian services to others.
- b) Or a person devoted to promoting the welfare of humanity, especially through the elimination of pain and suffering.
- c) Or a philanthropist.

(7) SCHOOLS/EDUCATION:

- a) Personal endeavors as a teacher **above and beyond** the call of duty.
- b) Or a citizen providing service to the schools as a volunteer.
- c) Or any individual promoting the cause of education within the community.

(8) GOOD NEIGHBOR:

- a) A neighbor who has on many occasions offered any of the following: Help, understanding, cheer, comfort or consolation in time of need.

(9) BUSINESS OWNER OR EMPLOYEE:

This award will be presented to an outstanding business owner or employee who:

- a) Has shown exceptional service, duty, assistance, cooperation and usefulness to the public in the performance/conduct of his or her job or business.

(10) MAYOR'S AWARD:

- a) Mayor's choice.
